Our Good Growth Plan

Syngenta launched The Good Growth Plan and set ambitious targets in 2013 to drive the way we add value to a sustainable agriculture system and quantify the difference we make.

Globally, here's what we achieved from 2013-2020:

- 18.8% land productivity increase: more efficient crop production
- 14.1m hectares of farmland were brought back from degradation
- 8.2m hectares of land were made more biodiverse
- 26.5m smallholders were reached with 28.5% land productivity increase
- 42.4m farm workers worldwide were trained in the safe use of our products
- 99% of suppliers in sustainability and fair labour programs
- The new phase of the Good Growth Plan will help make agriculture both greener and more profitable

In Canada, we're proud of our contribution to this global program. From 2013-2020, this includes:

- supporting nearly 7,300 hectares of diversity initiatives, including multi-functional field margins, biodiversity enhancement practices. This includes 180 on-farm diversity habitats in Canada.
- more than 25,000 hectares of Canadian farmland through minimal tillage and crop rotation to enhance soil conservation practices.
- helping train more than 1,300 people on safe use practices and the 5 Golden Rules for the safe use of crop protection products.

In 2020, Syngenta introduced the new Good Growth Plan with bold new commitments to reduce agriculture's carbon footprint and to help farmers deal with the extreme weather patterns caused by climate change.
