

ENOGEN FEED CORN STEWARDSHIP QUICK CHECKLIST*



- Read contract and Enogen Value Preservation Stewardship Guide
- ID and segregate Enogen seed
- Communicate planting intentions to neighbors
- Plant in contracted fields only
 - Provide field information to reseller to map and identify in system by required deadlines
 - This includes any changes to fields
- Plant Enogen seed with a minimum of 30 feet of non-Enogen corn or 30 feet of natural isolation (i.e., road, ditch, trees, etc.)
- Clean planter and all planter equipment of visible Enogen seed after Enogen planting complete
- Return or properly destroy all unused Enogen seed
- Provide required planting information and documentation to reseller for entry into system
- Harvest all harvested product from border rows together with Enogen harvested product
- Clean harvest equipment after Enogen harvest complete
- Provide required harvest information to reseller promptly after harvest
- Feed all Enogen harvested product only to livestock
- Do not sell or transfer Enogen product to any third party without Syngenta approval
- Follow transportation requirements if transporting as Enogen grain
